### LCD Projector Program

During the 2004-2005 school year, an LCD projector was awarded to each elementary, middle and high school in District 303. The Dukane Corporation, a local St. Charles firm, supplied the units at a specially-discounted price. All together the Foundation spent almost \$27,000 on the 17 projectors. Dukane also donated free of charge three promotional projectors valued at \$1,000 each. These units were given to District 303's three middle schools.
